The Bald Rock Baptist Church was founded approximately in 1861. It is Rockdale County's first African American Congregation. The worship services were held in a Brush Harbor, under the leadership of Rev. Charles Tuggle. This temporary structure served its purpose and was located on property not owned by Bald Rock church members. During this era, slaves could not own land. It is believed that the plantation in which Bald Rock Church was located served as a place of worship for those slaves that shared the same last name as their masters. As early as 1883 Bald Rock was one of the area churches to hold church school. The original Bald Rock Church structure is located on Costley Mill Road at the Georgia International Horse Park and is now a historic site.

The Bald Rock Baptist Church has been at its current location since 1994. The present Bald Rock structure was mainly built by the men of Bald Rock led by Rev. Jack Maultsby-Pastor, Deacons Robert Rome-Chairman, Frank Swift-Vice Chairman, Albert Banks, Willie Banks, Rufus Bigby, John Cox, V. Giles, Rufus Henderson, John H. Penn, Freddie Ross, Junior Robinson, Rufus Roseberry, A. R. Shaw, E. J. Shaw, and S. Strung.

Former pastors were: Rev. Charlie Tuggle Baker, Young, Hayes, Webb, Allen, Henderson, Sims, Rev. G. J. Clark (54 years), Rev G. L. Shaw (11 years), Rev. E.D. Harris (22 years), Rev. Sandy Allen (1 year), Rev. C. L. Mapp (3 years), Rev Jack Maultsby (3 years) and Rev. Jessie Henry Jr. (6 months).

The church is fortunate to still have descendants from early years still worshipping and working at Bald Rock: Andrews, Baker, Banks, Bigby, Easley, Henderson, Ross, Mitchell, Penn, Rome, Roseberry, Robinson, Shaw, and Swifts.

To date our church has celebrated 156 years. We are thankful for the many blessings God has provided us under our current pastor, Sr. Pastor Christopher Shipp. Bald Rock is experiencing a spiritual growth. His vision for Bald Rock is outlined in Matthew 28:19. Through the aid of the Holy Spirit, we will continue to *Learn the Word to Light the World*.

We thank God for every year, every pastor, every ministry, every member, every soul saved and our future for the best is yet to come!

156th Anniversary Guest Speaker, Morning Service: Reverend C.H. Glover

**Rev. C.H. Glover** grew up in a Christian home. His mother, Ollie Mae Glover, was a devout Christian mother for many years. Under that influence, Rev. Glover accepted Christ as his Savior at a young age and followed that action with believer's baptism.

Rev. Glover surrendered to the ministry in his early twenty's. After accepting his call in 1968, he studied under the leadership of E. D. Harris. It was doing that time that he was trained and prepared for leadership. Rev. Glover was ordained in 1968. His first ministerial assignment was the assistant pastor at Bald Rock Baptist Church of Conyers, GA. As he continued to grow and become known as a mighty spiritual leader, he was later called to be the assistant pastor of Macedonia and Middle Chapel of Conyers.

Continuing to walk in his calling, Rev. C.H. Glover was called to Pastor. His first pastoral position was as the Angel of Woodward Baptist Church in Atlanta, Ga. He remained there for 10 years. His responsibilities included: administrating the church membership program, including leadership; adult, youth, and children's choirs; ensembles and special presentations; visitation, Bible teaching; working closely with youth department to plan and implement youth activities and ministries, including discipleship training, Sunday School teaching, street evangelism, and visitation.

Upon fulfilling his assignment, Rev. C. H. Glover was called to Springfield Baptist Church of Covington, GA. He remained there as Pastor for 15 years. Later, he was called to Shady Grove Baptist Church where he served for 5 years. His responsibilities were similar to the position at Woodward Baptist Church.

For the last years, Rev. C. H. Glover has continued to walk in his calling fulfilling his purpose. Though there has been many trails and obstacles, his love for God and working in the vineyard has remained unstoppable and unchanged.

In his early ministry years, Rev. C.H. Glover married Elnora. She was a devout Christain Mother who bore him four children: Debra, Anthony, Regina and Marcus.

Overall, Rev. Glover has over 40 years of ministerial experience across all ages from children through senior adults. In addition Rev. Glover has significant background with nearly any aspect of church ministry: music, youth, children, administration, senior adults, married, singles, preaching and teaching.



156th Anniversary Guest Speaker, Evening Service: Pastor Andre' Lamont Clanton

A native of Bronx, New York, Rev. André Lamont Clanton attended North Carolina Wesleyan College in Rocky Mount, North Carolina where he graduated with honors in Justice and Public Policy and was listed among the 1996 edition of "Who's Who Among Students in America's Colleges and Universities?" Rev. Clanton decided to continue his education by attending Virginia Commonwealth University in Richmond, Virginia, obtaining his Maste of Education Administration degree and pursued a career in higher education administration. Rev. Clanton is currently pursuing his Doctor of Theology Degree in Pastoral Theology from the Andersonville Theological Seminary.

Rev. Clanton answered his call to the gospel ministry and was licensed in July 2002. He was ordained in October 2007. As a minister of the gospel, Rev. Clanton targeted his ministry to young adults and college-aged students. As an Associate Minister of The Second Baptist Church of Ann Arbor, Michigan, Rev. Clanton assisted in the creation of Mustard Seed Ministries on the campus of Eastern Michigan University in Ypsilanti, Michigan. As an Associate Minister at Bald Rock Baptist Church in Conyers, Georgia, Rev. Clanton founded and directed the Voices of Praise Gospel Choir and began the One Voice Ministry and Bible Study at Oxford College of Emory University in

Oxford, Georgia. As an Associate Minister at Mount Welcome Missionary
Baptist Church in Decatur, Georgia, Rev. Clanton work closely with university
officials to institute the African American Male Initiative on the campus of
Clayton State University in Morrow, Georgia, as well as established and
advised a chapter of the Student African American Brotherhood.

Rev. Clanton serves as Director of Student Conduct and Deputy Title IX Coordinator at Life University in Marietta, GA. As a higher education professional, Rev. Clanton has sought avenues by which to introduce Jesus Christ to college students and other university members. He is a member of the Association of Christians in Student Development as well as the Association of Student Conduct Administrators. As a college administrator, Rev. Clanton is working to increase the support of students of color by addressing issues of racism, discrimination, student retention, and emotional and spiritual support.

God has blessed Rev. Clanton with his wife, Monica, and six wonderful children. He is dedicated to spreading the gospel of Jesus Christ and is a charismatic motivational speaker, lecturer, teacher, and revivalist.
