The Obituary

Gloria Jean Green, 63, died peacefully on Sunday, June 2, 2013 at Northside Hospital in Atlanta, Georgia. She was born on May 26, 1950 in Pittsview, Alabama to Albert Sr. (deceased) and Pearl (Johnson) Wiley.

Gloria spent her earlier years in Alabama and grew up in Ft. Myers, Florida. She graduated from Dunbar High School in 1968. After high school, Gloria began her government career in February of 1969 with the Internal Revenue Service. After obtaining a few different positions with the government, Gloria later transferred to the Department of Health and Human Services (CDC) in October 1985 and officially retired on February 1, 2013 after 36 years of service. She was responsible for approving digital certificates for Statistics and Data Management Branch (SDMB) and Program Evaluation Branch. Gloria was responsible for setting up and maintaining activities on the Secure Data Network (SDN). In addition, she was responsible for setting up and supporting about forty SDMB activities and about twelve under the PEMS Program. Gloria's wealth of knowledge and experience will be missed in the Division of HIV/AIDS Prevention.

Gloria always enjoyed giving and helping others, both in her professional and personal life. She worked with the CDC SHARE Holiday Campaign by setting up the mitten tree for about twenty years. Gloria will surely be missed. We will always remember her as willing to help the less fortunate.

Gloria married Calvin Green in 2004, and they were happily married for nine years. Together they enjoyed attending church, traveling, and just being together.

Gloria aka "**Mother Green**" was a member of Bald Rock Baptist Church and was very involved with a number of Ministries within the church. Mother Green was the Program Coordinator and in these duties she had oversight for many of the church programs. She was the President of the Courtesy Ministry, Secretary of the Pastoral Care Ministry, Secretary of the Seniors Ministry, Vice President of the Women's Ministry, and assistant to the Trustees. She was a faithful servant and would do anything for the church and did it with a smile. Mother Green also managed the BRBC website and coined the phrase - "All Roads Lead to Bald Rock." Mother Green loved her Pastor and First Lady. She enjoyed cooking and baking, watching her Atlanta sports teams, and spending time with her family and grandson Ethan.
